For the control of flies, wasps, fleas, beetles, bedbugs, cockroaches, moths, ants and booklice in industrial/commercial premises such as food factories, hotels and hospitals (but not occupied ward areas) and in domestic premises. Product may be applied to hard porous and hard non-porous surfaces but is not for use on clothing or bedding

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Do not spray in the immediate vicinity of naked lights, hotplates, electric bulbs etc. Very lightly spray walls, ceilings and other surfaces at a rate of 1 litre per 100 square metres. For cockroach control: apply 1 litre of product per 50 square metres. Use a paint brush or roller where localised treatment is required. Treat all insect harbourages and breeding sites thoroughly.
