The coloured & clear preservers offer excellent protection for Log cabins, garden rooms, sheds, fences etc.

PREPARATION

Ensure wood is clean, dry and free from surface coatings, such as varnish, paint etc, remove as necessary. This preservative helps prevent the growth of new fungal spores but will not necessarily kill or control fungal spores already present. Prior to treatment with this preserver we recommend the use of a surface biocide such as Knockout Mould & Mildew cleaner. CAUTION - May not protect poor quality/contaminated timber from fungal growth/attack.

AGITATE THE PRESERVER BEFORE AND DURING USE.

Brush on, allowing to dry between application coats. End grain should be treated to saturation. Colour may vary from batch to batch - Mix well before use. Results may also vary depending on type and condition of timber being treated.

For Garden Furniture, Clear Wood Preservers are recommended as well as wood oils. Avoid contact with plastic, masonry etc.

Any spillages on bitumen type products may soften or swell with the fluid or vapour.

APPLICATION

On sawn timber two generous coats are normally sufficient, giving up to 8 sq metres per litre. On smooth planed wood best results will be obtained with 2-3 brush coats evenly applied. Reseal tin after use and clean brushes and splashes with Barrettine White Spirit. Drying time is normally 48-72 hours. But allow to dry thoroughly (up to 3 weeks) before introducing plants / animals into greenhouses, hutches, cages etc. Over time and subject to weathering a retreatment is recommended.
