Directions for use: Flymax[®] ULV Waste Management is a ready-to-use application. Shake bottle before use. Pour sufficient volume into the ULV fogger or mist blower chamber and apply the dose according to the recommended application rate. Reduce air movement in area by closing doors, windows and ventilators and turning off air conditioning. Smoke alarms should be isolated when product is applied. Refer to the Flymax[®] ULV Waste Management material safety data sheet for hazard and precautionary information before use. Direct fog upwards and directly at insects in the area to be treated. Repeat treatment as necessary to maintain control.

Flymax[®] ULV Waste Management is a non-biocidal product due to its physical mode of action and is exempt from EU Reg: 528/212.

The recommended application rate is 100 ml per 1000 m³


